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JUDGMENT

In accordance with, and for the reasons stated in the Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, judgment shall be entered whereby Plaintiff Tami Trepte and all Settlement Class Members shall take nothing from Defendant Sunbeam Products, Inc. except as expressly set forth in the Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and the Settlement Agreement attached thereto as Exhibit "A."

Each side shall bear their own costs and fees except as ordered in the Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Costs and Service Award.

This Judgment does not apply to Albert C. Ting and Carmen Magtibay, who have timely requested exclusion from the Settlement Class and are therefore not bound by this Judgment.


Pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure sections 578 and 664.6 and California Rules of Court, Rule 3.769(h), the Court, in the interests of justice, there being no just reason for delay, expressly directs the Clerk of the Court to enter this Judgment, and hereby decrees, that upon entry, it be deemed as a final judgment with respect to all claims by members of the Settlement Class against Sunbeam Products, Inc., in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

Without affecting the finality of this Judgment, this Court reserves exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over the Settlement and the Settlement Agreement, including the administration and consummation of the Settlement Agreement.

Notice of this Judgment shall be given to the Settlement Class by posting this Judgment on the Claims Administrator's website.
